

THE FOUNDATION

The Foundation for Southeast Texas is a community foundation with a not-for-profit 50l (c) (3) status serving Hardin, Jefferson, and Orange counties. Established in late 1996, the mission of the Foundation is to financially support and subscribe to the seen and unseen needs of nonprofits in Southeast Texas by encouraging invested donors to look forward while giving back. The Foundation responds to continuously changing and emerging community needs by addressing the following areas of civic and social concerns: arts and culture, preservation, education and scholarships, health, social services, youth and elderly, economic development, and civic affairs.

Occasionally a donor may wish to gift to a nonprofit beyond Hardin, Jefferson or Orange County. This is allowable, as is our reception of gifts from beyond these counties.

Applications for the Foundation's competitive grants are available in early January of each year. Awards are made in late spring. Applicants must be nonprofit organizations located in Hardin, Jefferson, or Orange County.

Anyone may donate gifts to existing Foundation funds. Memorials and honorariums are always welcome and will be acknowledged in the Annual Report and to appropriate individuals or groups. A permanent, endowed, named fund is easy to establish with a gift as little as \$10,000. Non-permanent donor-advised funds allow donors to make specific recommendations to public charities at the donor's convenience. Scholarship funds may be established by groups or individuals with a minimum gift of \$25,000. Nonprofit Agencies are welcome and encouraged to establish their own endowments with the Foundation. Donors may give gifts of cash, securities, or property. Additionally, the Foundation may be named the beneficiary in a will, trust or insurance policy. The donor may designate the charity to be gifted or allow the Foundation to distribute gifts to qualified grant seekers.

The Foundation funds are managed by First Financial Trust. The Investment Committee of the Foundation oversees the fund managers and reports to the Foundation's board.
