after October 1, 2023. Fee must be paid when registering.

All motorized vehicles must present proof of insurance when submitting entry. All insurance and driver's licenses will be checked on site as well- so please have them readily available.

*Remember this is a family-oriented event. Only appropriate music, costumes and banners will be allowed. No refunds if you are late or removed from the line. *

HORSES- Copy of current Coggins Card must be submitted with application. Any horses not registered before the parade will NOT be allowed to participate. If you show up without a current Coggins, you will be asked to remove your animal and exit the parade route

There will be NO stopping and exiting vehicles, visiting, etc. along the way. Entries should remain a safe distance from the entry in front of them, but there should NOT be any large gaps. The parade should be continuous. Anyone stopping along the route causing delays in the parade will be pulled from the parade lineup immediately.

*All schools are invited to perform at the end of the parade at opening ceremonies. This includes cheer, flag, dance, and battel of the bands.

*All dance and cheer walking groups may NOT stop during the parade and perform by the parade judges.
