Take Hwy #24 south, through, Cambridge to County Rd #5 / Blue Lake Rd #35. Turn right on Blue Lake Road. It comes to a T junction at East River Road. Turn left on East River Road. The camp is just down the road on your left.

FROM HIGHWAY 403

Take Paris Road exit and go north towards Paris. At the intersection with Hwy #5 (Tim Hortons), continue going straight until you come to a T junction at East River Road. Turn right on East River Road. The camp is just down the road on your right.
