BRAESIDE FACILITIES

Other facilities include a tuck shop, full-size heated swimming pool with lifeguard, toddlers' wading pool, skateboard park, horseshoe pits, volleyball and basketball courts, baseball and soccer fields, children's playground, picnic area, ping-pong tables, etc.


DIRECTIONS FROM HIGHWAY 401

Take Hwy #24 South through Cambridge to County Rd #5 / Blue Lake Rd #35. Turn right on Blue Lake Rd. At the T intersection, turn left on East River Road. The camp is on your left.

DIRECTIONS FROM HIGHWAY 403

Take Paris Road exit and go north towards Paris.

Continue straight through the Hwy 5 intersection (Tim Hortons) until you come to a T junction at East River Road. Turn right on East River Road. The camp is just down the road on your right.
