Crowd:

- gather around Jesus
- with Him three days
- asked for nothing but Jesus' presence

Pharisees:

- come to Jesus
- immediately question Jesus to test Him
- ask for a sign

2. Notice the difference in what they <u>receive</u> from Jesus:

Crowd:

- Jesus' compassion
- Jesus performs a sign
- they all eat and are satisfied (physically & spiritually)

Pharisees:

- Jesus "sighed deeply"
- Jesus does not perform any sign
- Jesus leaves-they are left empty, with nothing
