WHAT WE'RE LOOKING FOR

We are currently seeking to hire multiple Reclamation Monitoring Technicians to assist with reclamation monitoring in our Wyoming operations based in Rawlins, WY. We offer competitive pay (starting \$20/hour depending on experience) with overtime potential and provided lodging. Positions are full time and seasonal, from April through November 2024. Employment beyond these dates is possible depending on project needs.

Projects and duties include:

- Conduct environmental compliance monitoring (vegetation monitoring and stormwater inspections).
- Assess site specific vegetation health and biodiversity.
- Follow monitoring protocols to collect accurate data on vegetation types, density, and distribution.
- Analyze collected data and prepare reports summarizing findings and suggesting mitigation strategies.
- Map new and existing features using ArcGIS Collector on tablet computers.
- Identify plants using a key.
- Navigate using digital maps.
- Keep up with environmental regulations and vegetation monitoring and land management practices.





Additional job tasks may include:

- Manage weeds using truck, ATV/UTV, or backpack mounted herbicide spray equipment.
- Assist with erosion control and maintenance.
- Assist with other reclamation projects.
