


# **Athena: Maximizing Collaborative Research**



Developed to better apply the on-going research by operationally experienced Marines at the Naval Postgraduate School, *Athena* is an online collaborative research tool that allows researchers, sponsors, and leaders across the Naval Education Enterprise to access and query information currently stored in numerous separate databases. By connecting NPS students and faculty with research topics that the Navy or other branch has identified as important, Athena furthers NPS' mission of timely research in support of our nation's defense. The platform also allows for researchers across Naval education to connect when their research coincides.


