Guest Lecture with Admiral Cecil Haney, USN (Ret)

Great Power Competition in the Cognitive Age



On January 26th at 3:00 PM PST, NPS will host a Secretary of the Navy Guest Lecture (SGL) with Admiral Cecil Haney, USN (Retired). Admiral Haney retired in January 2017 after 38 years of distinguished service in the U.S. Navy. As a 4-star Admiral, he commanded the US Strategic Command (2013-2016) responsible for strategic capabilities involving nuclear weapons, missile defense, space and cyberspace and the US Pacific Fleet (2012-2013) responsible for the manning, operations and maintenance of the US Navy fleet located in the Pacific and Indian oceans. As a career submariner, he had command of the fast attack nuclear submarine USS Honolulu (SSN-718), Submarine Squadron ONE (Pearl Harbor, HI), and Submarine Group TWO (Groton CT). He now serves on the Johns Hopkins University Applied Physics Board of Managers, the Naval Studies Board, the Aerospace Corporation Board of Trustees, the Board of Directors for General Dynamics Corporation, Systems Planning and Analysis Inc., the Center for a New American Security, and is Chair of the Board of the Military Child Education Coalition.
