Naval Studies Warfare Institute

The Naval Warfare Studies Institute (NWSI) was established in 2020 to support NPS's updated mission and increase focus on being responsive to emerging and evolving naval warfighting concepts and capabilities. The institute is a hub of experts that enable teamwork and collaboration within the NPS innovation ecosystem. They coordinate NPS's interdisciplinary research and education to accelerate and enhance warfare concept and capability development while also preparing students for future conflict. NWSI provides Navy and Marine Corps organizations who have complex operational problems, perceived warfighting gaps, or pressing analysis needs access to NPS' 600 technical experts and 1,600 mid-grade, operationally experienced officer students. NPSAAF Director of Research Funding Aisha Maroon spoke with NWSI Director Jeff Kline about the organization and its role at NPS.
