ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Learners must be able to communicate in English (reading, writing, speaking and listening). Learners must be 18 or over to undertake this qualification and apply for the necessary SIA licence to work.

ASSESSMENT

Two externally set and externally marked multiple choice exams marked by LASER.

Each exam:

- is administered by centre staff under examination conditions.
- has a 70% pass mark.
- assesses one unit.
- lasts 60 minutes.
