


Approaching Pronouns At Work

What Are Pronouns?

Pronouns are third-person pronouns that an individual chooses to be referred by to indicate their gender identity. Some examples of pronouns are:

She/Her

He/Him

They/Them

Remember judging a person by their appearance is not an accurate or inclusive way to identify someone's gender identity.

How To Approach Them At Work
