

Hope Shores Family Camp Confirmation & Instructions

Dear Friends:

Welcome, we have received your registration for Family Camp at Hope Shores. Here are a few things you will need to know in preparation for a great weekend together.

- Your \$75 Deposit is non-refundable unless we can fill your spot. The balance is <u>due</u>
 <u>2 weeks before your weekend at Camp</u>. Please log into your account and pay the final payment using our online system.
- 2. Directions are at the end of this letter to help you find Hope Shores. It's easy to follow and it takes about 2 hours to get there from the Twin Cities. Please check in at the Lodge when you arrive.
- 3. Please plan to arrive Friday night between 6:00 and 7:00 p.m., so you don't miss any of the excitement. Our awesome staff will be ready and waiting to help you get checked in, find your cabin, and unload your vehicle. If you arrive after 7:00 pm, check-in at the Lodge to receive information for the weekend.
- 4. For cabin sleeping arrangements, you must bring a fitted sheet to cover each bunk (state law) and a sleeping bag/blankets and pillow w/case for each person in your group. If you have children too small for a bunk, please bring a pack-n-play for them.
- 5. Please leave your pets with a friend or in a kennel. Sorry, but Hope Shores has no accommodations for these loved ones.
- 6. Please bring 2 dozen of your favorite treats/snacks to share. Put your name on your container if you want it back.
- 7. **What to bring to camp:** Bible, notebook, pen, clothes for indoor and outdoor activities, swimsuit, towels, washcloths, toiletries, lawn chairs, etc.

This year we'll have a "Starry Night" theme for our Banquet Night. Come with an outfit that fits into this theme! Make it your own and be creative.

Other equipment you may wish to bring: money for camp store (souvenirs, camp shirts, sweatshirts, and hats), camera and accessories, flashlight, mosquito repellent, sunscreen, Frisbees etc., a favorite board game, and a white t-shirt for tie-dye.

Please note: Canteen (pop, candy, snacks) is included in the registration fee.

- 8. Come prepared for our annual talent show that will take place on Saturday night with an act, props, etc.
- 9. There is only limited fishing equipment, so bring your own if you plan to fish. You will need a fishing license, so if you plan to fish, please purchase one before you come.
