

A Letter from our President

In the Great Commission, our Lord calls the church to the worldwide evangelization and discipleship of all nations. It's a massive vision—far greater than anything a single church or organization can accomplish alone. It requires the entire church, a gospel partnership from all who call upon Jesus as Lord.

The difficulty of achieving the Great Commission lies not just in the scope of the vision. Some places and people remain hard to reach. For example, there remain 1,300 unengaged and 7,000 unreached people groups in the world. Getting the gospel to these groups requires concerted prayerful effort and a lot of hard work.

But the challenge is not just "over there." What if we also include the vulnerable and neglected neighborhoods and communities in our own cities and towns? And what if we factor in our stubborn fear, distraction, and lack of awareness? How many people in our own cities face an eternity without Christ because fresh and revived gospel work goes on everywhere but their neighborhood? I shudder to think about it. The need is great.

But then I rejoice. I rejoice because of your partnership in the gospel. By supporting The Crete Collective, you help us to make some small impact on the eternal destinies of people who might never hear the gospel otherwise. Because you share in our vision to start and revitalize gospel churches in neglected and vulnerable black and brown neighborhoods, souls are saved, lives are changed, and hope is spread. Like yeast quietly and invisibly working through dough, the kingdom is spreading in forgotten and abandoned communities. It may not look impressive now, but when the annals of heaven reveal all that God has done, we will marvel! We will marvel at how God took so many widows' mites to do so much where so many feared to go. We will marvel at how God moved so many partner churches to contribute to neighborhoods other than their own for the glory of God in the gospel. We will marvel at how many siblings we may only meet in heaven. And we will thank God for the privilege.



That's our hope at The Crete Collective. On behalf of the Board of Directors, member churches, and church planters, that is why we thank you for partnering with us, for sharing the vision with us, and for hoping in God with us. On that great day, many "will glorify God because of your submission that comes from your confession of the gospel of Christ, and the generosity of your contribution for them and for all others" (2 Cor. 9:13).


