Elder– when learning equivalent fractions, paying attention and putting in an excellent effort to extend his knowledge.


Charlie—For trying hard all week. You have been loud and proud in our phonemic awareness. Keep up the great work.


Michael – For applying himself to learning and practising the class concert dance.




