# Principal's Message

Dear parents and carers

This week I have spent a delightful two days with our grade 3 students at PGL Campaspe Downs. It was the first school camp experience for most of the students. My sincere thanks to Mr Miller and Mrs Redman for organising and supervising at the camp with me. As always, the students were exemplary in their behaviour, and it was wonderful to see how enthusiastically they participated in every activity. They challenged themselves to move out of their comfort zones and wholeheartedly supported each other. It is always a joy to be with our students at events such as this. Well done to every student!

I was contacted during the week by a local resident who expressed concern about pedestrian safety on the busy corner near the Tylden General Store. He noted that traffic can be moving quickly, despite the speed limit, and it is difficult for children to cross safely there. If your children travel to school via this route either on foot or by bike, please remind them to be very careful. Perhaps they could cross the road at the Clayton Street corner which is past the Tylden Hall towards Woodend.

The first day of our School Review was on Wednesday. The panel visited all classrooms during literacy and mathematics sessions, and gave very positive feedback. The school captains, wellbeing leader and junior school council met with the panel and had a comprehensive discussion that covered many aspects of school life. Thank you to the group who attended the parent/carer forum to give

feedback to the review panel. The second day of the review will be on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October. On this day we will develop the next 4- year School Strategic Plan.

Next Thursday is our annual House Athletics Sports day. Parents and carers are warmly invited to attend to watch the events, and to bring lunch to share with their children. The day starts at around 9:15am with the annual Paper Plane Challenge. Children should make their paper plane at home and bring it on the day.

Grades 1 &2 have been working with fractions in maths over the last 2 weeks.


As a concluding activity they used their fraction knowledge to measure ingredients and make some 'Fraction Biscuits'.
