The Product Owner will also have a strong focus on requirements gathering by liaising with external partners and internal team members. With the requirements gathering tasks, comes a level of organizational skill which is needed to manage external projects with external partners.

This is a remote / work from home opportunity. Ideally, you are local to Winnipeg.

Duties of the role include:

- Convert business requirements into specifications and/or user stories for development.
 - Drive working sessions to understand requirements.
 - Ensure requirements are clearly documented and coordinate approval and full understanding of requirements by all parties (including internal and external stakeholders).
 - Manage requirements projects and delivery timelines and track to timelines to ensure smooth/on-time/high-quality implementations.
- Perform a Business Analyst role in an agile development with ability to research or answer questions as they arise.
- Assist in prioritizing development team backlogs to streamline execution of priorities while maintaining integrity of the features being developed by the team.
 - Ensure feature/bug backlog items are clearly defined and prioritized.
 - Ensure development team members understand items in the backlog and get clarity on ambiguous items.
 - Work with development team leads to coordinate work amongst development teams.
 - Report on progress of epics, tasks, and on completed work (this is a collaborative effort with development team leads).
 - Work with all teams to help ensure tasks remain on target and actively communicate with stakeholders should issues arise.
 - Perform business acceptance testing with focus on targeted testing along with some end-to-end feature testing.

Qualifications required:

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent experience in Business Analysis and/or Information Technology.
- 3+ years of experience as a Product Owner or Business Analyst.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- An understanding of the financial services technology space.
- Scrum or Agile experience.
- Able to manage and prioritize workload with competing deadlines.
- Able to work independently and collaboratively with a team.
- Detail oriented.
- Strong research skills.
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills with ability to analyze data.
