Background & Purpose of the IC3 Movement

With its mission to bring career and college counseling to every school, the [IC3 Movement](https://www.ic3movement.com) is committed to providing guidance and direction to every young person across the globe to find career paths through education that will lead to fulfilled, happy and productive lives. Focused on empowering high schools with training and resources to better support the leaders of tomorrow, the work of the IC3 Movement is driven by the values of inclusion and access, and has reached 93+ countries through its various initiatives, which are led by more than 1,000 volunteer-based IC3 Leaders and IC3 Advocates.

The IC3 Movement's mission is "counseling in every school."

Committee Overview

The IC3 Presidential Committee, led by one Chair and one Co-Chair and consisting of six to 10 additional committee members, known as IC3 Leaders, will lead the effort to galvanize fellow thought leaders across the spectrum of schools, universities, and industry to exchange ideas on the criticality of counseling in schools to help young people realize their full potential. In particular, this group will provide leadership and vision for the IC3 Presidential Forum, a two-day event that runs parallel to the Annual IC3 Conference & Expo each year that brings together senior leaders across the education field. With the understanding that senior education leaders are the chief mentors at their schools and institutions, the Presidential Forum provides a platform to bring awareness to new avenues of learning to emerge in higher education and to give clarity to paradigm shifts in the world beyond schools.

Responsibilities of IC3 Presidential Committee Leaders

- Contribute to setting the vision and developing content for the Presidential Forum, under the direction of the Committee Co-Chairs and in collaboration with the Chair/Co-Chair of the Annual IC3 Conference & Expo
- Contribute to the development of the overall program theme/topic, structure, flow, and detailed agenda
- Collaboratively cultivate dynamic panelists and presenters
- Collaborate in the recruitment of attendees from within their networks of senior education leaders in India and around the world (IC3 team will provide the necessary communications support and resources for marketing/branding)



- Actively participate in the IC3 Presidential Forum and will ensure successful implementation of the vision and content at the event (the IC3 team will take the lead in managing event logistics)
- Commit to participation in a monthly committee call (schedule to be determined by committee leadership)

General Responsibilities of IC3 Leaders

- While taking individual action, leaders should be representative of the IC3 Movement – the Annual IC3 Conference & Expo, the IC3 Institute, the IC3 Regional Forums, and IC3 Live
- Commit to regularly reviewing all IC3 materials and websites and fully understand IC3's mission, policies, programs, and events
- Commit to accurately representing information on IC3
- Ideate and define content that will be most valuable for participants at various IC3 events
- Actively monitor session content during IC3 events and provide feedback after these events
- Garner in-person feedback from participants at IC3 events to continue enhancing IC3 content for future events
- Track and announce important IC3 developments within their networks
