Keeping everyone connected

Microsoft Teams brings employees together on the departmental and organizational level. An optimized environment is easily customized, and the integration possibilities are extensive.

A few ways Teams keeps you connected:

 Teams and Channels can be built at whatever level suits your organization and departmental needs.

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• Tabs within Channels allow departments, or groups within departments, to set up an environment with all the tools they need for the job at hand – all just a click away.

When your team is working in harmony, you will see a rise in productivity and time saved.

Time saved

Not only can Microsoft Teams help you bring departments together to work effectively in a Team/Channel, but the lack of need to jump from application to application saves critical time for employees. Scaling that time for every employee across your organization can quickly add up to millions of dollars in cost savings per year.

Projected Benefits, according to Forester's "New Technology: The Projected Total Economic Impact™ of the Microsoft Teams Platform" report, productivity savings from using Teams over three years are between **\$8.8M and \$21.7M**. This increase in productivity is due to the platform's ability to **shave off 15 to 25 minutes per user's day**, on average.

Facilitate basic HR and IT-related inquiries

While Microsoft Teams leading to better communication and collaboration should enable more camaraderie and co-learning, there will always be a need for basic HR and IT related questions to be answered.

Rather than spending needless hours or minutes searching, or interrupting colleagues with personal questions, adding in a chatbot to automatically answer general IT and HR-related questions can help you achieve another big win.

Projected Benefits, according to Forester's "New Technology: The Projected Total Economic Impact™ of the Microsoft Teams Platform" report, chatbots can **reduce the burden on Help Desk and HR requests by 10% - 15%**.

Applied Communication and Collaboration benefits

There are so many departmental scenarios, needs, and pain points that Teams can address. The possibilities for different configurations of the application are endless. One of the examples mentioned in Forrester's report related to the healthcare sector highlights the following:



This innovative use of Microsoft Teams saved physicians and nurses between 30 and 90 minutes per day by streamlining processes and eliminating inefficiencies. In a year, those same physicians and nurses will save between 65 and 108 hours using the application.

Yammer as your breakroom

Since most of the buzz has been around Microsoft Teams, you might be wondering, "is Yammer still relevant?" Absolutely, and it has advantages you will want to leverage on your journey to a more social digital workplace. Yammer is a great place to have social interactions between colleagues without adding more clutter to your Teams channels. Instead, save those conversations for Yammer.




Figure 1 - Take a look at the Yammer lookbook!



SharePoint as an Intranet

For over a decade companies have been relying on SharePoint for their Intranet. A strong indicator of its relevance is how many times the application has been the foundation for the Neilson Norman award, the equivalent of winning a Grammy in the Intranet space. While many have relied on it as the foundation for their Intranet, SharePoint has taken things up a few notches, enabling advanced capabilities for engaging with your employees. Their modern UI/UX is as simple to use as a Square Space website, and as easily configurable. If you are not already using SharePoint for your Intranet, you should know their users have doubled year-over-year, and it is for a good reason.



SharePoint is at the heart of Microsoft 365's digital workplace solutions and even the backbone for some. Its purpose includes improving the overall employee experience and engagement through effective communication and collaboration. Fortunately, SharePoint's purpose aligns with Microsoft's commitment to a better digital workplace, and the results have been outstanding.

Take advantage of a growing platform

There are a few reasons why powering or running your Intranet on SharePoint supplies significant advantages. SharePoint's cloud-first features and ability to help you scale rapidly drive its innovation. This sets your Intranet on a path to continuous growth and improvement.

Cloud-first features

Cloud-only features will only be available to organizations that use the cloud platforms or integrate Microsoft 365 with their on-premises solutions. Innovation is bundled with SharePoint Server for on-premises SharePoint environments.

On-premises VS online

These SharePoint releases are based on the innovation that happens in SharePoint Online and Microsoft 365. In many cases, you may wait several years before a SharePoint cloud-based feature is available on-premises.

For example, the last version of SharePoint Server was feature locked, based on the innovation/code and testing cycles, at the start of 2018. That means that, in 2021, SharePoint 2019 is closer to 3 years old when it comes to innovation and improvements in SharePoint Online.

What about a hybrid scenario?

Some SharePoint Online features may never be available for On-Premises. SharePoint Online connects to Azure enabled services like Video Streaming, Deep Analytics/Insights, or Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence capabilities. These capabilities might not be as richly available in a hybrid configuration, or some elements may require added licensing. However, you can expect that innovation is both cloud-first and sometimes cloud-only.

Employees can securely and responsibly access the Microsoft 365 Intranet anywhere, at anytime and on any device without a VPN. With built in and integrated multi-factor authentication that supports rapid login from apps, biometric sensors, Windows Hello and more.



Setting up and managing your policies is simple. You can apply device-specific security policies to ensure that data is synced and accessible only on authorized phones and tablets. What's more Microsoft supports app management policies and the protection of your data across enterprise apps.



Reduce the risk of data leaks and increase control. When you need to wipe Microsoft 365 data from selected devices, you can do it remotely and safely.


Microsoft 365 Innovation




Integrated contextual experiences



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
