


WHAT IS MIFTAAH + MYNA?

Class Title: Sacred Foundations: 40 Hadith of Imam Nawawi

Course Description:

This class is an introduction to the comprehension of primary religious sources in their original language and forms the basis of one's ability to interpret, analyze, and apply Islam's holy texts. Using the concise and to-the-point sayings of God's Messenger (pbuh) collected in the classical text The 40 Hadith of Imam Nawawi, students will begin to utilize concepts learned in their morphology and syntax classes to understand the Prophet's (pbuh) words. A discussion of the grammar and vocabulary included in each hadith will be accompanied by a lesson on the hadeeth meaning and a discussion of its application in our place and time.

Enrolled students are provided with course books that are custom made for the Miftaah curriculum. Digital copies are provided for every subject, as well as necessary answer keys and supplemental readings.

POWERPOINTS

When available, course PowerPoints are provided on the student portal. PowerPoints are custom made by the Miftaah team and cover only the necessary topics and information needed to complete the program.

COURSE NOTES

At the end of sessions, notes are provided for select course subjects. Notes are a great way to review course material for upcoming exams.

RECORDINGS

All classes will be recorded and available after class in a video library on the student portal. Students will have lifetime access to the recordings.

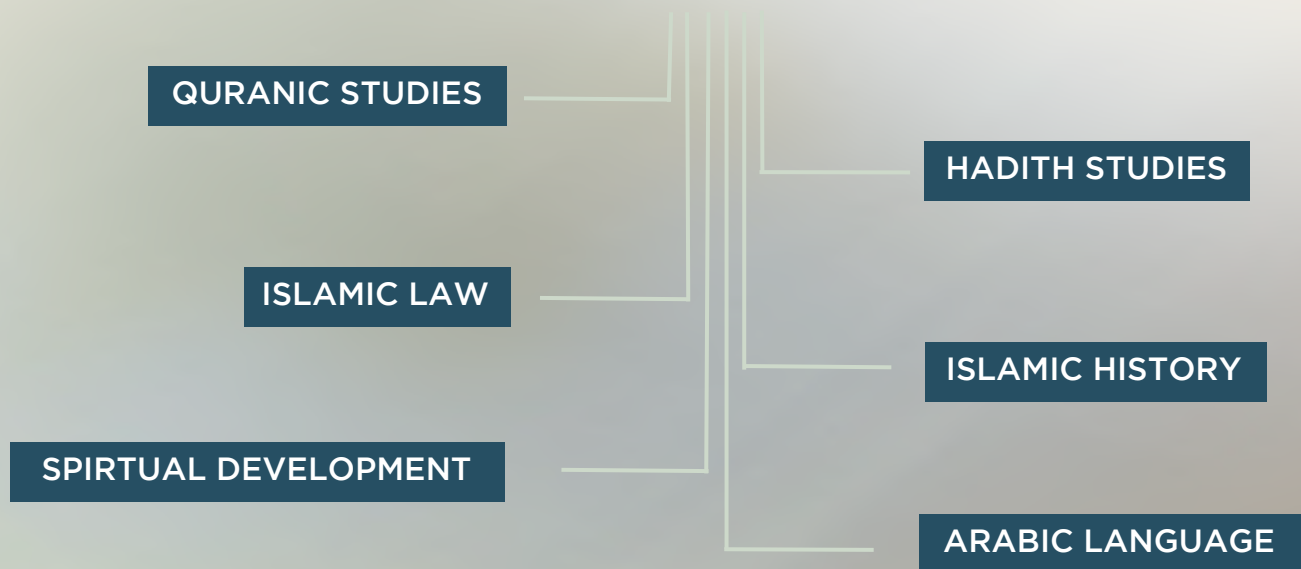
TESTING AND EXAMS

One of the main factors that distinguish our program is its graduation requirements. To complete the program and graduate, students must receive a passing score for each course. To complete the Miftaah + MYNA Seminary program, the student must complete at least 8 courses.

After completing 8 courses from the Miftaah + MYNA Seminary program, students are encouraged to transfer to the Miftaah Online Program.


