
## PRE-PRIMARY DIVISION

The academy's curriculum, designed by Academy Director Debi Janea, is a development of multiple historic ballet syllabi and styles. Valuable teachings such as theory, steps, terminology, and combinations are taken from methods such as Cecchetti, Vaganova, Bournanville, Balanchine, and others. These lessons are placed into a student's training at the appropriate time of their growth as young dancers and are designed to progress students forward at a quality level of skill and technique.
