

CRAIG-BOTETOURT ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE SCHEDULE RS-13

AVAILABILITY

Available in all territory served by the Cooperative, subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Cooperative on file with the Virginia State Corporation Commission.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to Members of the Cooperative for single-phase and three-phase residential and residential/farms, schools, seasonal services, ball fields, churches and community halls.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase, or three-phase if available at Member's service location, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

MONTHLY RATE

I. Distribution Delivery Service:

Consumer Delivery Charge:

Single-Phase	@	\$34.00	per month
Three-Phase	@	\$40.00	per month

Demand Delivery Charge:

All kW Delivered	@	\$0.05	per kW*
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Energy Delivery Charge:

All kWh Delivered	@	\$0.04824	per kWh
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II. Electricity Supply Service Charges:

All kWh sold	@	\$.08096	per kWh
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* The Demand Delivery Charge will not be billed until all Customers served on this tariff have the necessary metering equipment installed. The Cooperative will notify the Commission before including the Demand Delivery Charge on Customers' bills.

Note: The above Distribution Delivery Charges and Electricity Supply Service Charges apply to those Customers who have the Cooperative as their energy service provider. Only the Distribution Delivery Charges apply to those Customers who have an Electricity Supplier other than the Cooperative as their energy provider.

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RESIDENTIAL SERVICE SCHEDULE RS-13 (continued)

MINIMUM MONTHLY DISTRIBUTION DELIVERY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge for distribution delivery service under the above rate shall be the applicable Consumer Delivery Charge. Whenever the Cooperative disconnects a Customer at the Customer's request, and the Customer requests reconnection at the same premises within thirteen-months of the requested disconnection, a charge equivalent to the sum of the Consumer Delivery Charge for each month the service was disconnected must be paid before reconnection is made.

BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the Customer's maximum kilowatt integrated demand measured for any 60-minute clock hour period from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during the month for which the bill is rendered.

PCA

Service under this schedule shall be subject to the provisions of Schedule PCA-1 and the member shall be billed for the PCA factor in effect.
