FOUNDATIONAL SCRIPTURE:

GENESIS 25:27—34 (NIV) — 27 The boys grew up, and Esau became a skillful hunter, a man of the open country, while Jacob was content to stay at home among the tents. 28 Isaac, who had a taste for wild game, loved Esau, but Rebekah loved Jacob. 29 Once when Jacob was cooking some stew, Esau came in from the open country, famished. 30 He said to Jacob, "Quick, let me have some of that red stew! I'm famished!" (That is why he was also called Edom.) 31 Jacob replied, "First sell me your birthright." 32 "Look, I am about to die," Esau said. "What good is the birthright to me?" 33 But Jacob said, "Swear to me first." So he swore an oath to him, selling his birthright to Jacob. 34 Then Jacob gave Esau some bread and some lentil stew. He ate and drank, and then got up and left. So Esau despised his birthright.

- Some of us are hungry because our needs are treated like neediness.

HUNGER IMPACTS OUR:

- Focus the ability to concentrate on a priority.
- Fortitude strength of mind. I. It wears down your resistance to resist things that aren't good for me. There is never an excuse but there are reasons.
- Fragility delicateness or easily broken.

WHAT DOES A MAN NEED TO HEAR?

- Admiration. Admiration impacts what you say and how you say it.
- Appreciation. Appreciation means there is recognition of the contribution that a man is making.
- Attraction.

WHAT KIND OF NEEDS DOES A MAN HAVE?

- Emotional needs. Scriptural Reference Ephesians 5:33 (NIV) 33
- Men receive respect as love.
- A man is hungry to be loved for who he is and not what he hunts.
- Men are conditioned to find value in achievement.
- Recreational needs. Scriptural Reference Ecclesiastes 5:18-20 (NKJV) 18
- There is a kid inside of the kid. Let him play. He needs the recreation respected.
- Relational needs. Scriptural Reference 1 Corinthians 7:3 (NIV) 3
- There is one store that a man can shop in, and he needs the shelves stocked with what he can only biblically get from you.
