

BIG IDEA

We have all experienced betrayal somehow, either as the betrayed by someone or as the betrayer. "We also have all betrayed God. But there is good news no matter how you've betrayed him, Jesus will forgive you if you turn to him in faith and receive his love for you and respond to his love by living for him."

THOUGHTS FROM THE SERMON

- 1. Read Mark 14:43-72. What stood out to you in the reading?
- 2. How were you impacted by the message this week?
- 3. What was your response to the questions asked about betrayal this week?
- 4. Who did you see yourself most like in the story of Jesus' betrayal? Peter, the other disciples, or Judas? Why?
- 5. What did we learn about us betraying God? Why is that hard to hear?
- 6. What was Peter's biggest mistake? (Hint: It was not his betrayal of Jesus.)
- 7. Despite our betrayal, what is the good news for us today?

PERSONAL REFLECTION AND APPLICATION

- 1. As the questions on betrayal were being asked, how many times could you have honestly raised your hand?
- 2. How have you personally been impacted by betrayal? Have you forgiven your betrayers? Have you forgiven yourself?
- 3. Who do you personally relate to in our scriptures this week? Why?
- 4. How can you personally find healing and restoration in your betrayal of God?
- 5. How will you personally apply what you learned from the sermon to your life today?
- 6. How can your group hold you accountable this week? How can they encourage you?

DEEPER

Pray: Take time this week to pray for each member individually. At your next meeting, follow up with each other's prayer requests. Start to pray for those you want to invite to one of our services at Easter.

Read: Mark 14:43-72 and 1 Peter 2:21-25. Take time to reflect on these passages and write down your thoughts.

Sing: Visit https://www.gatewayepc.org/news and listen to the worship songs from Sunday throughout the week. Look up the lyrics to each song and spend some time reading them as well.

Memorize: As a Life Group, pick a few verses from the sermon and memorize them this week. (Mark 14:43-72 and 1 Peter 2:21-25)
