First Communion classes begin at 6.30pm on Tuesday, 18th October in the Upper Room.

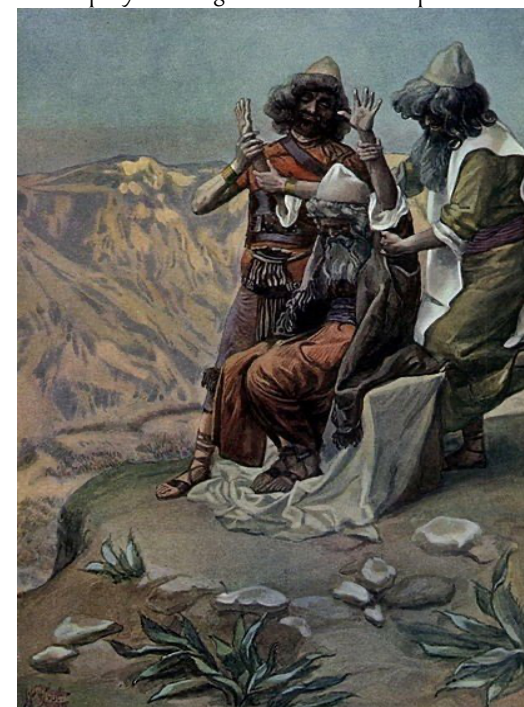
Confirmation classes begin at 7.30pm on Tuesday 18th October in the Oratory House.
