



DEDICATION OF ST WILFRID'S CHURCH

This Friday, 14th July is the feast of the Dedication of St Wilfrid's. You may wonder why, given that the church was opened in 1864, it wasn't consecrated until 1945. At any rate, the impetus for that moment was the necessary work that had to take place after an incendiary bomb in the Museum Gardens blew out the windows above the High Altar. 14th July is the one day in the year when the twelve consecration candles around the church are lit. These mark the places where Bishop Thomas Shine anointed the walls with chrism in 1945.
