



FEAST OF BLESSED SALVIO HUIX MIRALPEIX



Blessed Salvio was a member of the Oratory at Vic in Catalonia, and became Bishop of Lerida. He was exemplary in his defence of the poor and implementation of the Church's Social Teaching. In July 1936 he handed himself in to the Republicans, to avoid reprisals against others. He continued to minister to his fellow-prisoners, until on $5^{\rm th}$ August he and twenty others were taken to the cemetery to be shot. Bishop Salvio asked to be killed last, so that he could bless the other victims. When he was shot through the right hand, he continued to bless with the left.
