

WHITE FLOWER APPEAL

Today we have the annual second collection for the Society for the Protection of Unborn Children. SPUC's vision is for a world where abortion is unthinkable. This year's appeal calls for HM Government to end the pills-by-post DIY abortion policy.

As well as ending the lives of precious babies, this policy lacks safeguards against illegal late-term abortions, and puts mothers at physical and psychological risk. 86% of GPs are concerned that this scheme leaves women vulnerable to coerced abortion.
