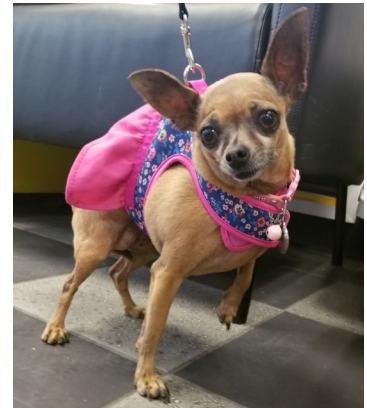




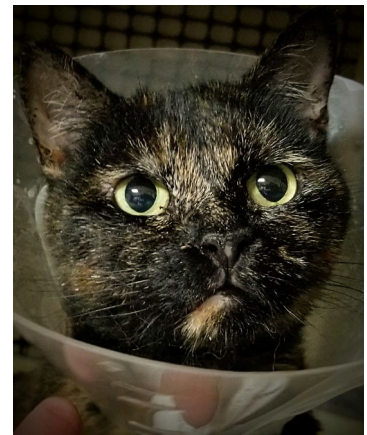
Dear Happy Tails Supporter,
