**The Degree program includes all of the courses offered in the diploma program. In addition, there are five degree electives each school year. This will ensure that each student receives the most robust Kingdom content as they work towards their Bachelor's Degree in Biblical Studies.

This course will provide students entering KINEO Ministry Training Center with information, discussions, and activities that will promote their understanding of their role in KINEO, as well as their role in the Body of Christ.

An introduction to the authorship and contents of the New Testament books. Special attention will be given to important persons, places, events, as well as to key chapters in the New Testament revelation. This course is structured to help the student interpret New Testament biblical passages in their proper context. Within the New Testament, there are insights to mankind, teachings for virtuous living, truths about the Savior, and principles for living an abundant life for Christ. The student will also be challenged to evaluate traditional and critical options of interpretation.

These first seven weeks of studying Elisha's life and ministry place heavy emphasis upon his initial calling and training, his miracles over illness and infirmity, miracles over nature, and becoming an instrument of miraculous supply in times of need.

The Life of Elisha helps us all to discern the days in which we are presently living, and it empowers us to live and serve as those through whom God desires to manifest His power to an unbelieving world.

Most discerning Christians know that something is clearly wrong with the American Church model. Yet, do we understand what it is that is amiss, and why it is so? When churches return to the apostolic model chronicled in the Book of Acts and described in the epistles of Paul (primarily in Ephesians 4:11-16), churches will become transformational in whatever cities they are planted.
