<p>International Student Costs</p> <p>Medical Insurance - estimated at approximately €150</p> <p>GNIB card/registration – estimated at approximately €300</p> <p>Visa application consultant fees</p> <p>Flight costs and transfers</p> <p>Visa refusal administration charge (only in the case of visa refusals – €200)</p> <p>Extra-Curricular Trips (excluding programme related visits)</p> <p>Living costs in Ireland, estimated at around €7,000 per annum</p>	<p>Tax Relief</p> <p>Any programme undertaken at Holmes Institute Dublin is approved for tax relief at the standard rate of income tax. The person who has paid the fees may claim the relief.</p> <p>The maximum amount of income tax relief you can claim is €7,000 per course, per person, per academic year.</p> <p>Each claim is subject to a single disregard amount of €3,000 (FT) or €1,500 (PT) each tax year.</p> <p>Further information on income tax relief can be found here.</p>
