

CAMPING RULES 2024



By reserving your campsite, you agree to the following:

- All campers are required to purchase event tickets. Campsites can only be purchased by those that have a weekend pass. All campground occupants must always wear their event wristband once exchanged for their ticket. Lose or tamper with your wristband and you must purchase a new ticket. If you have a problem with your wristband, report directly to the Will Call/Ticket booth.
- 2. Each campsite is made for 1 (one) vehicle and 1 (one) camping unit (trailer). If you wish to add a tent, that is allowed but you MUST remain within the boundary of your campsite. Trailers or tents are allowed on any site, with the exception of Tent City, which is for tents ONLY.
- 3. Price for camping is per site, not per person and for the entire weekend Wednesday through to Sunday, inclusive.
- 4. Campsite and layout subject to change without notice or compensation.
- 5. All vehicles, towed trailers and campers MUST be licensed, plated and road legal. No home made, livestock or utility trailers allowed. Modified trailers must have proper ventilation, windows and emergency exits. All doors must be able to open from both the inside and the outside. All trailers must have working smoke and CO2 detectors and liquid propane alarms (if applicable). Any trailers deemed unfit can be refused entry into the festival grounds at the discretion of LMITF, Security or OPP without compensation to the ticket holder.

**If you are unsure if your trailer is allowed, please email <u>info@musicinthefields.ca</u> with pictures of all doors, windows, inside and outside of the trailer for verification.

- 6. Campers under the age of 19 MUST be accompanied by an adult (19+) who assumes responsibility for the entire campsite and its occupants. Camping is for all ages, however only those 19+ are permitted to purchase a campsite. Any campsites found not to have someone 19+ camping at that site is grounds for eviction.
- Re-entry of vehicles is allowed. All vehicles re-entering camping MUST have a sticker AFFIXED to their windshield to get back in. Re-entry is only allowed during camping registration times and through GATE 3 (Walter St.) Wednesday and Thursday, and GATE 1 Friday and Saturday (Washington St.). If/when gates are closed, overnight parking is available at "Lucknow Community Centre" (649 Campbell St.) or the Soccer fields (790 Havelock St. N).
- 8. **NO GLASS BOTTLES** they will be confiscated without compensation. ONLY cans and plastic allowed.
- 9. **NO PETS** are allowed on any of the festival grounds, including camping, with the exception being service animals with current rabies vaccination.
- NO OPEN FIRES ALLOWED. This includes propane fire pits. BBQ's, grills or small cooking appliances are allowed for cooking ONLY - propane only. Cooking appliances are to be used under the following conditions:

- a. Only use propane as the primary fuel.
- b. Only one (1) cooking appliance per campsite.
- c. Must bear a certification from a nationally recognized certification agency.
- d. Maximum amount of propane per campsite may not exceed 30 pounds.
- e. One meter (1m) of clearance must be kept around the appliance at all times.
- f. Appliances may only be used from 7AM-2AM.
- g. When in-use, appliances may not be left unattended.
- 11. Garbage/Recycling Bagged garbage and recycling is picked up daily from campsites and new bags will be handed out. Please help our volunteers by separating your garbage, recycling and returnable alcohol containers. MESSY CAMPSITES ARE GROUNDS FOR EVICTION.
- 12. Alcohol is to be consumed on your campsite. **NO alcohol is allowed on campsite roadways or to be brought into the concert area.** Please note that this is a rule set out by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario and beyond our control.
- 13. All campers are expected to be courteous to those around them. Quiet hours are 1:00 AM to 9:00 AM so as not to disrupt nearby campers. Failure to comply may result in eviction from the event grounds at the discretion of LMITF, security and/or OPP without compensation to the ticket holder.
- 14. No amplified sound systems.
- 15. Generators are allowed on site, but patrons may be asked to turn them off if use is loud or excessive. Generators must have a maximum 5 gallons of fuel. Battery packs are okay in tent camping. (Lucknow Fire Department reserves the right to alter any of these guidelines based on local bans and weather conditions).
- 16. All vehicles and persons will be subject to search upon entering the grounds and prohibited items must be surrendered.
- 17. No mudding or cruising around the campsite. Once your vehicle is in, it should be parked for the weekend. Any person operating or riding in a motorized vehicle in the campgrounds or any roadway, which is not leaving or entering for the day, is subject to immediate evacuation from the event without a refund. Bicycles will be permitted in the camping areas only.
- 18. NO FIREWORKS, paper (floating) lanterns, incendiary devices or any type of explosive are prohibited.
- 19. NO personal ATV's, scooters, golf carts, etc. (personal accessibility vehicles exempt). Bicycles are okay.
- 20. No household furniture (couches, recliners, etc.) allowed on campsites.
- 21. Medical/First Aid services will be available on site during the day.
- 22. LMITF is not responsible for lost or stolen items or damages that may occur to personal property during the festival. Please ensure all of your belongings are locked and secured when you are away from your campsite.
- 23. LMITF reserves the right to confiscate any items on campsites that are not permitted as outlined above, or that may be offensive to other campers.
- 24. **CAMPSITES MUST BE COMPLETELY CLEANED UP PRIOR TO EXIT.** Failure to comply will result in a cleanup fee of \$500.00 being charged to the on-file credit card for this campsite.
