What is your objective for this activity?

**What:** a sequence of illustrations or images that outline the key elements and events of a story **Why:** a visual aid to communicate ideas or sequences effectively before implementing them.

- 1. Choose a single persona and storyline you'd like to focus on and, as a group, caption each step of your story
- 2. Use images, icons, annotations, or simple sketches to set the scene for each step.


### FAQs


### Example

#### i What's the issue?




At home, hungry, at suppertime. Fridge is empty. Wants pizza.

#### i) What are you doing differently?




Decides on curbside pickup, since it's free. Gets a text message for free parking, with a time and directions.


#### i Success!
