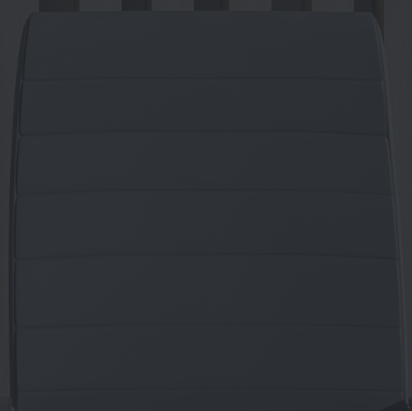

Acacia Melanoxylon

Tasmanian Blackwood is an appearance grade timber, suitable for furniture and interior applications. It has a golden-brown heartwood, often with narrow bands of darker colour that are indicative of the growth rings. Sometimes reddish streaks are present.

Grain is usually straight with occasional wavy portions that produce a lovely fiddleback figure. Known for higher levels of timber colour variation, ranging across all brown spectrums. Also known as Blackwood or Black Wattle.
