Necessary cookies

Necessary cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.

cfruid	This cookie is a part of the services provided by Cloudflare - Including load-balancing, deliverance of website content and serving DNS connection for website operators.	Session
m	Determines the device used to access the website. This allows the website to be formatted accordingly.	2 years
rc::a	This cookie is used to distinguish between humans and bots. This is beneficial for the website in order to make valid reports on the use of their website.	Persistent
rc::c	This cookie is used to distinguish between humans and bots.	Session
referrer_user_id	Necessary for the website's booking functionality.	14 days

Statistics cookies

Statistics cookies help website owners to understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously.

Name	Purpose	Expiry
_ga	Registers a unique ID for the session. This cookie is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses a website.	2 years
_gat	Used by Google Analytics to throttle request rate.	1 day
_gid	Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses a website.	1 day

Preference cookies

Preference cookies enable a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region you are in.

Name	Purpose	Expiry
_calendly_session	If consent is given by the visitor, this cookie allows the website to add events into the visitor's calendar.	21 days
