

The modernist American composer Arthur Berger is the subject of BMOP/sound's 31st release, *Words for Music, Perhaps.* The disc includes five of Berger's compositions for varying chamber ensembles, from the 1940s (*Words for Music, Perhaps*), 50s and 60s (*Chamber Music for 13 Players; Septet*), and 90s (*Diptych: Collage I and Collage II*), including his last composition in 1996, *Collage III.* Pioneering but underrepresented, Berger's compositions, though few in number, expanded the sonic possibilities of post–WWII modernist music. The music on this disc provides an arc of his compositional oeuvre and is played with precision and panache.
