

Mackey's idiom, a multi-layered world of rhythm and sonority, draws its expanded harmonic palette from Western art music, its wit and vivacity from the imaginative transformation of popular music elements. His chamber music sometimes features re-tuned instruments and microtones. His orchestral works display consummate skill in their handling of instrumental color and texture. His concertos offer a fresh look at the medium. In his first concerto, *Banana/Dump Truck* from 1994, the ensemble plays a jazzy vamp as the cello soloist emerges from the wings like a variety show guest.



Albany Records is devoted to music by American composers (with a few notable exceptions) performed by the best of America's artists. From premiere recordings of orchestral music by Roy Harris, Morton Gould and Don Gillis to music by George Lloyd and Andrei Eshpai, there is something from everyone on Albany Records—provided your interests are just a bit out of the ordinary.
