
Echoing Isaac-Smith's wish to extend the Rebel Hearts story, Kos also believes there's

more to tell that couldn't squeeze into the 99 minute runtime of the discovery+


documentary. He said "Absolutely. Especially the story post-1970s there's so much there and so many twists and turns we weren't able to get to. Even though the film is coming out this week,
