

Realscreen unveiled the winners of its 13th annual awards at the Realscreen Summit in Austin, Texas on Tuesday (Jan. 24).

The awards celebrate outstanding content from across the global non-fiction and unscripted entertainment industry. This year's edition was hosted by Ann Pornel, the comedian, actress, and co-host of the CBC's Great Canadian Baking Show.


Realscreen's Awards of Excellence brought multiple awards for hit titles like *The Great British* Bake Off, The World According to Jeff Goldblum, The Tinder Swindler, Love on the Spectrum and Betsy & Irv.

Netflix was the biggest winner among networks. with six awards split between four of its titles (Love on the Spectrum, Love Is Blind, The Tinder Swindler and Queer Eye). Channel 4 followed with four awards, while Apple TV+ picked up three.

The ceremony also honored the newest inductees into the Realscreen Hall of Fame. This year's honorees were Academy Award-winning documentarian Alex Gibney (Taxi to the Dark Side, Going Clear: Scientology and the Prison of Belief, Enron: The Smartest Guys in the Room), and Eli Holzman and Aaron Saidman, Sony Pictures Television executives and longtime producing partners whose super-indie Industrial Media was acquired by SPT in 2022.

The Realscreen Awards also honored Hue You Know founder Bree Frank with its inaugural Action Award, which recognizes individuals within the unscripted and non-fiction film/TV industry who are working to create positive change within both the industry and the world at large.


Frank has produced nearly 300 hours of unscripted TV, including MTV's Room Raiders.
