VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Sunraysia regions have a climate well suited for growing vines, with warm summer days and plenty of sunshine, allowing ripe fruit flavours and sugars to develop. In 2021 we had warm days, cool nights and little or no rain. This led to excellent ripening conditions resulting in bright, ripe fruit.

VITICULTURE & WINEMAKING

The grapes are grown on vines aged 15-20 years, planted in calcareous earth. They are harvested into temperature controlled stainless steel tanks where they undergo fermentation, with the influence of American and French oak. No animal based fining agents were added making the wines vegan friendly.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: Medium purple.

Aroma: Packed full of bright red berry fruits with hints of mulberry, white pepper, star anise and mint. A dash of chocolate and spicy oak adds a more mature angle to this young and energetic Shiraz.

Palate: This elegant wine is packed full of vibrant red fruits with hints of blueberry, blood plum and vanilla. A fine tannin structure adds a delightful textural element to a long, lingering finish.
