### Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

We have taken actions to build net zero capacity within the organisation by: appointing a designate manager, creating a cross- business working group and by implementing a capacity building programme for staff.

Soon (and in time for our reduction target of 25%) we will implement further measure such as:

- Switch to renewable energy
- Encourage EV and public transportation with business travel
- Reduce business travel
- Reducing waste to landfill through new waste contracts
- Introduce a new net zero procurement policy
- Addressing “hot spots” in our supply chain
- Launch new emission reduction initiatives for all our businesses
