
### HOW TO REGISTER

### **VOTING BY MAIL**

- 1. Request your mail-in-ballot with a mail in application.
- 2. Fill out the application.
- Submit the request to your local election office. Make sure you request your ballot far in advance.
- 4. When your ballot arrives, read the instructions to complete it and return it.

The deadline to request a mail in ballot and have it received by is Tuesday, October 27th, 2020.
