Notes of volcanic basalt, peach, sage and peat with a saline finish. This wine comes from the highest vineyards within the Fiano di Avellino area, giving the wine higher aromas together with higher acidity and overall longevity. — 13%

A blend of the best parcels from the top vineyards on different sites around the active volcano. 20 Anni brings together the seductive spiciness of Sciaranuova, the firm structure of Guardiola, the delicate florality of Rampante, the succulent red berryfruit of Porcaria, and the pungent vegetal notes of Chiappemacine, crafting an exquisite embodiment of the Passopisciaro terroir.
