

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE LATEST GDPR RULING

In an update to the Schrems II ruling last year, the Court of Justice of the European Union (CJEU) updated their guidance for Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs), the mechanism in which companies providing services to European residents could transfer data from the EU to countries like the U.S in compliance with GDPR. In response, Atlassian has published new, compliant SCCs, which can be found within Atlassian's Data Processing Addendum.

In addition to regulation in financial services, Atlassian Enterprise also complies with the precedents outlined in the HIPAA Security, Privacy, and Breach Notification Rules, supplying you with a safe and secure environment for you to conduct your business with peace of mind.

What is the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA)?

The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) is a regulation developed by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and is designed to protect the privacy and security of people's protected health information (PHI). HIPAA applies to healthcare providers who electronically transmit health information in connection with certain transactions, health plans, and healthcare clearinghouses, as well as other third parties, known as "business associates", that create, receive, maintain, or transmit PHI on behalf of covered entities.

Atlassian Enterprise provides comprehensive privacy and security protections that enable Cloud customers to operate Atlassian products in compliance with HIPAA.

These include:

- · Security measures for protecting PHI.
- Assessments for reasonable remediation or mitigating controls of addressable HIPAA Security Rules.
- An annual HIPAA Security Attestation, Gap Assessment, and Security Risk Analysis.
- The regular review and retention of HIPAA Security policies and procedures.
- Security awareness content regarding the protection of ePHI and the designation and role definition of a HIPAA Security Officer.

Customers who are subject to HIPAA compliance and want to partner with Atlassian must purchase an Enterprise Plan and enter into a Business Associate Agreement (BAA) that covers the applicable products and services. Additionally, Atlassian has created a HIPAA Implementation Guide that customers will need to read before inputting any data. This will ensure each customer uses Cloud products and services in a HIPAA-compliant way.
