This course is designed to help trainees gain a basic understanding of the Incident Command System, its organization, principles, basic structure and common responsibilities. Training Content:

- What is Incident Command

- Roles and responsibilities of the Incident Commander and Command Staff.
- Roles and responsibilities of the General Staff.
- When it is appropriate to expand and contract the ICS organization.
- Identify the facilities used in ICS.
