<u>County Website:</u> This notice must be posted on each internet website relating to elections maintained by a county.

<u>Polling Place:</u> This posting must be placed in prominent locations at each entrance where voters may see it while waiting in line. The form(s) must be posted prior to the opening of polls and cannot be taken down until the last voter completes the voting process.

#### **Comments/Instructions:**

Instructions to Election Judge and Polling Place Workers:

- 1. Post this notice at each entrance in the polling place where it can be read by persons waiting to vote.
- 2. An election officer must allow a voter with mobility problems, and any assistant, if requested, to be moved forward in line and be processed before other individuals who arrived at the polling place before that voter.
- 3. An election officer must monitor the line periodically for voters who appear to be eligible for voting order priority and offer them the opportunity to move to the front of the line.
- 4. An election officer cannot require a voter requesting voting order priority to submit proof of the mobility problem.
