

# **ORDINANCE #2021-18**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS FUTURE LAND USE, BY CHANGING APPROXIMATELY .52 ACRES LOCATED AT 394 WARD DRIVE FROM VOLUSIA COUNTY URBAN LOW INTENSITY (ULI) TO CITY OF OAK HILL LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (LDR) PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, BY REZONING APPROXIMATELY .52 ACRES LOCATED ON 394 WARD DRIVE FROM VOLUSIA COUNTY URBAN MOBILE HOME (MH-6) TO CITY OF OAK HILL URBAN MOBILE HOME SUBDIVISION (MH-1); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.
