Everything we do is about Jesus and advancing His Kingdom mission forward. This means your ministry is not yours, it's His. So none of this is about you, but it includes you. All of you, working together with open hands and humble hearts for His Glory and our good.

DREAM BIGGER

Always imagine what could be if God showed up. We never want to be defined by what we can do, but rather what God can do through us.

NEEDS BEFORE NEW

Prioritize meeting the existing needs of the church before starting something new. Even if the new thing is more fun. Even if the existing thing is less fun.

WORK SMART

Aim to complete the work with excellence, but also efficiency. This means partnering with others, but also managing the project for the greatest return on investment.

SEE IT THROUGH

Finish the job or hand it off. Period.

HONOR THE CLOCK

Being on time is important. When we're late it doesn't only affect us, it affects everyone around us. Early is on time...so plan ahead, don't make others wait.

REMEMBER WHERE YOU STARTED

It's easy to assume "someone else will do it" but at Highlands, no job is beneath you. We must be willing to flex beyond our job descriptions to keep things moving forward.

CELEBRATE CONSTANTLY

Church work is hard. We must identify wins and find opportunities to celebrate as often as we can.
