
BUILDING POLICY

We take pride in our 128-yearold building and ask students and families to do the same. We encourage parents and students to keep our facility a pleasant and well-maintained environment for everyone.

Food and beverages, with the exception of water, are not allowed in any carpeted areas of the building at any time, including Royce Auditorium.


Gum chewing is not allowed in the building.



PARKING

Parking is available in the lot adjacent to the south of the building. If the gate arm is down, press and hold the button on the yellow "call box." While holding the button state that you are arriving for rehearsal, then release the button immediately. This signals the receptionist at the front desk. The gate is not able to open while you are holding down the call button.

If the SCMC parking lot is full, you may park in the First United Methodist Church parking lot off of Barclay if their gate is open. The FUMC lot is located one street east of Ransom off of Fulton (Lot #3 on the map.)
