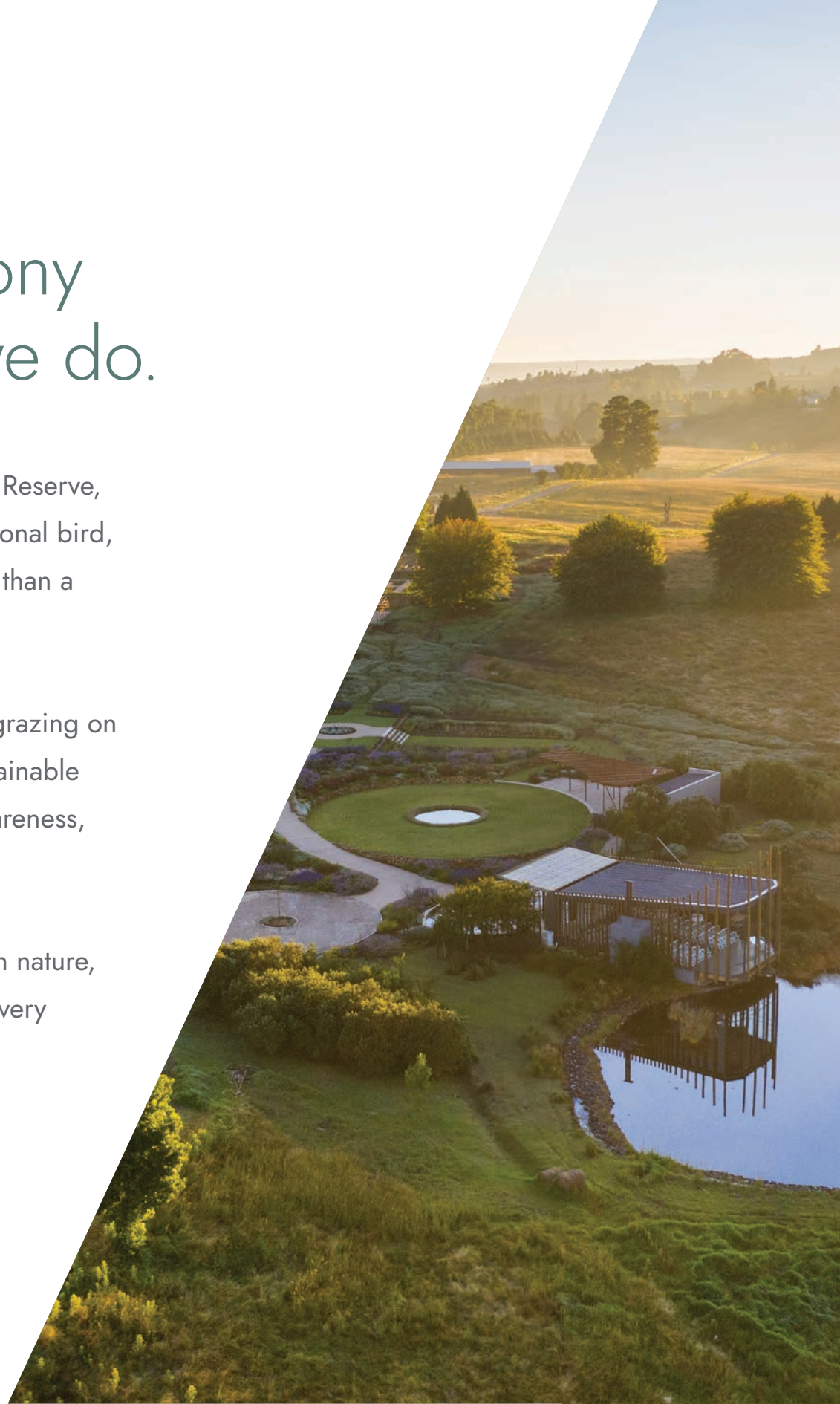


Creating harmony in everything we do.

Tucked away in the Blue Crane Nature Reserve, named in honour of South Africa's national bird, the Blue Crane, Brahman Hills is more than a destination, it's an experience.

We have an impressive list of wildlife grazing on the hills, and we run a completely sustainable operation based on environmental awareness, quality, and a passion for our people.

For us, it's about creating harmony with nature, our customers and our employees in every way possible.



We operate off-the-grid with solar power to protect the planet's resources and minimise our carbon footprint by eliminating the mentality of wastage by turning our food waste to Bokashi, which is a component that adds nutrients and improves our soil texture.

Our borehole water is natural and chemical-free and our in-house irrigation and wastewater system is something of which we're very proud.

With a sophisticated purification process that provides water for both irrigation and drinking, by the time it's cycled through our system, we always have a fresh, clean water supply that's essential to all life at Brahman Hills.



A story of resilience, perseverance and a dream.

During lockdown we couldn't look after guests, prepare meals or host weddings. But, we could create a garden!

Our chef was transformed from a culinary connoisseur to an irrigation specialist. Our staff were in the trenches digging ditches and bringing structure to the flower beds. Even our General Manager got in on the garden act, becoming chief specialist cement mixer and pourer.

Not only is the garden a magical place to amble around, but it also serves an essential function. We grow, harvest, and prepare all seasonal produce ourselves, right outside our kitchen door.

We maintain a safe, pesticide-free environment in our lush gardens so that bees can pollinate and thrive! With 16 beehives on-site, our beekeepers extract over 200 litres of raw honey which is put to use in our kitchen.

Brahman's bees are integral to maintaining healthy ecosystems and supporting our environment.

finest artists.

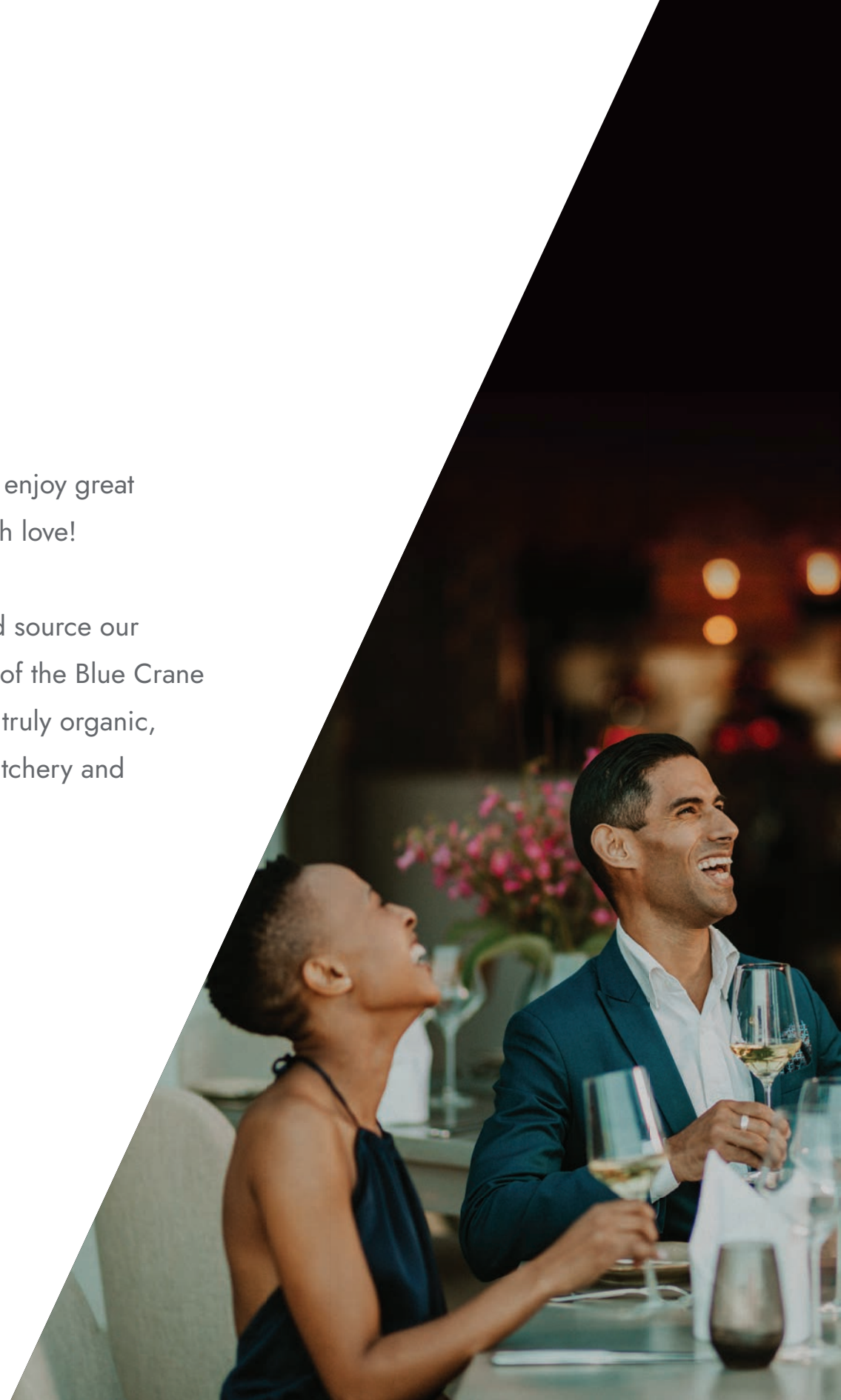

We always make our guests feel like family and strive to provide exceptional experiences, first-class service and hospitality every time.

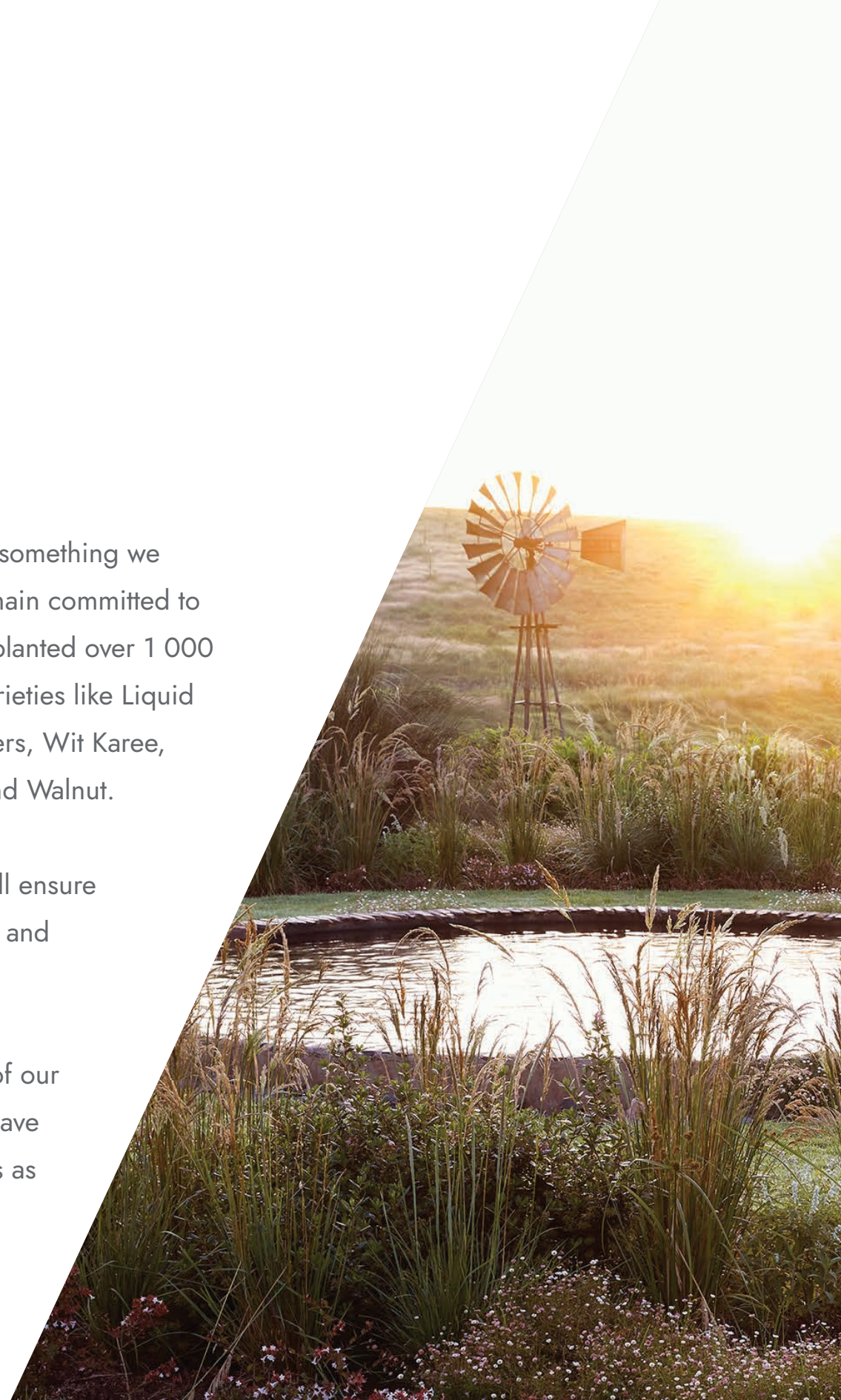


Creating a legacy for the future.
