Ages: 0-2

Use anatomically correct language for all body parts to help normalize talking about all body parts without fear or shame.

This technique also works as a protective warning to offenders as it signals to adult predators that your child is capable of talking about their genitals and therefore could testify effectively in court. It also signals that you are actively involved in your child's life and likely that your child will share information with you.

Vulva is the correct term to describe the whole female genitalia **Breast** and **Nipples** are the correct terms to describe the female chest area

Penis and **Scrotum** are the words to describe the two parts to the male genitalia

Anus is the correct word to describe the end of the intestinal tract.
